

Hampshire Constabulary has seen a small number of incidents reported linked to speculation and prejudice as a result of the coronavirus outbreak - and local Chinese communities may be feeling more fearful of being victims of crime.

We would wish to reassure the Chinese community, that hate crime perpetrated through ignorance, prejudice or hate is not acceptable and Hampshire Constabulary will do all it can to stop this type of crime.

We would encourage people to report any hate crime/incident to the police on 101 or 999 in an emergency, or through the network of third party reporting centres
